## Notes from the Headend

The NMRA was originally founded in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 1935 as the official model railroading standards organization. It was formed because modelers wanted to get together and run their equipment together – and couldn't, because it wasn't built to the same standards. But first, modelers wanted to get together. Without dropping into fields (psychology, sociology, anthropology) I'm not only not an expert in but am fairly bad at, humans as a general rule crave community, particularly with their own kind. It was this desire that led to the creation of the NMRA – so modelers could run trains with one another, at the simplest level.

One of our members, Phil Selinger, wants to do that locally. Phil is an HO-scale model railroader living in NW Portland, and he'd like to network with one or more other modelers in the local area. Phil models the Ma & Pa (Maryland & Pennsylvania) Railroad circa 1914, the Pennsylvania RR circa 1914, and has Royal Bavarian German display layout based in the 1920s. The German layout features full catenary and is 3 ½' x 10' in size and 95% complete. The proto-freelanced 2-track Pennsy layout is 50% complete and is located on a shelf above the Ma & Pa layout – the two are not connected. **Phil** will be one of our two presenters on January 21<sup>st</sup>, with a presentation on the Maryland & Pennsylvania Railroad and how he is modeling it in an approximately 21' x 15' room. **Robert Leatha** will be our second presenter, with a clinic on how he built the helix on this layout.

January will also see the conclusion of the **Blue Box modeling contest** – hopefully you were able to acquire one or more of the Blue Box kits donated to 2<sup>nd</sup> Division to use in creating whatever you desire – a diorama, a kitbashed model, or something completely different. Greg Baker will be judging the contest, if only to keep him from winning it. Greg won the first Walthers National Model Railroad Build-Off (<a href="https://forum.mrhmag.com/post/great-northern-ho-scale-2%E2%80%99x4%E2%80%99-layout-walthers-national-model-railroad-buildoff-entry-12216086">https://forum.mrhmag.com/post/great-northern-ho-scale-2%E2%80%99x4%E2%80%99-layout-walthers-national-model-railroad-buildoff-entry-12216086</a>) as well as the first contest 2<sup>nd</sup> Division held last year – with a diorama that didn't even exist 8 hours before. **Craig Larsen** will present on his Cascade and Deschutes layout, and will also have his layout, located in SW Portland, open for visitors after the meet.

2<sup>nd</sup> Division was the recipient of a sizable donation of model railroad equipment over the summer, some of which was taken by members at meets, some of which was taken for the Blue Box contest in January, and most of the remainder of which was sold at the Rickreall Swap Meet at the beginning of the month. 2<sup>nd</sup> Division netted \$383.20 at the swap meet after paying for the tables.

#### The 'Rules':

- 1.) Must Attend either the September or October meeting in person to choose your kit.
- 2.) Picking the kits will take place during breaks and AFTER the meeting.
- 3.) Choice of kit will be first come first pick, if we run out of kits we will allow people to use their own stash of kits, but the goal is to use the donated cars first.
- 4.) You must bring your completed creation to the January 21<sup>st</sup> 2023 meeting in Wilsonville and give a brief presentation (5 minutes or less) about what you did.
- 5.) At least 50% of the original kit must be used in your creation.
- 6.) Voting will be conducted by non-participating board member(s). The judging will be on judges preference, not using merit criteria for this activity!

Everyone will you have a new creation to add to your layout, or a new car to add to your train. The 'winner' as chosen by the judges will also walk away with a gift certificate from one of the local hobby shops!
